**GAS INFORMATION**

1. Gas bills are due on the 15<sup>th</sup> of each month. If not paid by or on the 15<sup>th</sup> you are subject to a late fee of 10%.
2. Gas prices are fluctuating and are subject to change with no warning.

**NORTHWESTERN WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT MCCOMB UPDATE**

While January temperatures were above normal, the extreme cold over the holidays was a good reminder to prepare your plumbing for cold weather. It's a good idea to locate the main water shut-off valve for your home or business in case of a pipe burst. You can also leave cabinet doors open during extreme cold to prevent pipes from breaking. It's also good to keep a plumber's phone number on hand in case you need assistance in thawing any frozen pipes.

**Projects**

Crews continue to work through the winter as weather permits on the \$642,000 sanitary sewer replacement project along Walnut and Railroad Streets. Construction should wrap up in the spring.

Work on the \$7.5 million McComb regional waterline, supplying water from North Baltimore to the village, is on hold and will resume this spring.
