NORTHWESTERN WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT MCCOMB UPDATE

The waterline project on N. Liberty Street, W. Main Street, Pleasant Street, and on N. Walnut Street has wrapped up with paving work now complete. We appreciate everyone's patience with this project.

The District received a \$50,000 grant from the state's new H2Ohio program to identify and map lead service lines. The District plans on using the funds to examine water lines in the Village of McComb. According to Engineer Tom Stalter, "This funding will help us determine if there are lead water lines in McComb, where records don't exist. We will then use that data to see if there is a need for a project to replace any lines."

So far, 94% of The District's over 17,000 water lines have already been identified, mapped, and determined not to have lead. The District will have more information for McComb residents before the identification project begins in the fall.

Finally, you are invited to join us at our Open House, Tuesday, August 16 from 3 p.m. until 7 p.m. Tour our main facility at 12560 Middleton Pike in Bowling Green and enjoy bounce houses, giveaways, food, and more. We hope to see you there.

We Do Not pick up grass clippings. They can be dropped off by residents in the grass pile.

PROJECT ZONING REMINDERS

- Any outside building project (shed, pool, porch, fence, gazebo, new building, etc.) requires a zoning permit.
- Applications are filed at the Village office. You will need a sketch of the project along with relevant measurements of any fence, building, etc. as well as distance from all property lines. Our goal is to have your permit ready in 3-5 business days unless your application needs to be reviewed with the Planning Commission.
- Reminder- The Village is not responsible for determining property lines. If property lines are in dispute, the property owners are responsible for obtaining a survey at their own expense.
- Building on easements is not permissible and can result in sheds moved and fences taken down at the owner's expense.
- Call the Village office in advance if you need assistance locating easements, permissible use questions and ordinances governing outside projects.
