LEAF PICK UP



It's that time again! Once again, the Village street crew will be doing their best to provide leaf pickup as a service to our residents. We ask you to rake your leaves into piled rows in / near the right of way for your home location. We will be announcing schedules of when different areas of town will be picked up as we work this fall commitment.

The street crew would also like to remind residents not to put grass clippings or tree limbs in with the leaves. Please keep grass clippings out of the roadway and storm drains to help prevent clogging the drains or creating a road hazard. Please do not leave grass on the sidewalks.

MILITARY BANNERS

The Village plans to rehang the previous military banners next year along with newly requested ones. If you would prefer not to have yours rehung, you may contact the Village office and pick it up. NORTHWESTERN WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT MCCOMB UPDATE

The \$7.5 million McComb Regional Waterline project, which will supply water from North Baltimore, was recently awarded to Hillabrand & Sons Construction LCC and B. Hillz Excavating Inc. Construction is expected to start in the spring of 2023 and be complete by 2024.

We've started the project to identify lead service lines. Crews have completed checks on approximately 30 homes out of 100. Once we identify any services made of lead, a future project to replace those lines will be designed.

Contractor Edward Kelly & Sons will start Improvements to McComb's sewer system, following sewer work in Hoytville in October. This \$642,000 project will replace sanitary sewer mains and lateral lines along Railroad and Walnut Streets and will be complete in the spring.
