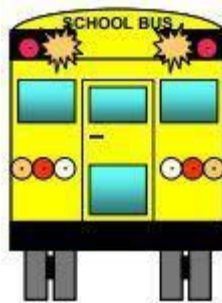

It's that time again as the end of August is near, football is underway and yes believe it or not Fall is around the corner. Once again, the Village street crew will be doing their best to provide leaf pickup as a service to our residents. **BURNING ORDINANCE**

The Village has put into effect a burning ordinance for the downtown area. As of July 11, 2022 Ordinance Number 2022-08 has been put into effect. A copy of the Ordinance is available in the office. If you have any questions, please contact the office at 419-273-0321.

**NORTHWESTERN WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT MCCOMB UPDATE**

The project to identify lead service lines in McComb will begin in September. At this time, we are looking to investigate 100 homes in McComb. While it will not impact water access, this project involves excavating water service lines to identify their material. The awarded contractor is B Hillz Excavating, and they will perform this \$50,000 project. If we identify any services made of lead, a future project to replace those lines will be designed. Homeowners impacted by the project will be sent a letter with more information.

Improvements to McComb's sewer system continue this fall when The District starts work on a \$642,000 project to replace sanitary sewer mains and lateral lines. Edward Kelly & Sons will be the primary contractor for this project.

Work will take place along Railroad and Walnut Streets and will be complete in the spring. A letter with more details will be sent to those of you impacted by the project.
